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Purpose of Course:

This course introduces financial accounting techniques, measuring and recording transactions, preparing financial statements, managerial decision making, and planning and control devices, such as budgeting, cost accounting, capital budgeting and break-even analysis. It also includes assessment of financial information from managers, lenders, and investors' perspective to understand evaluation of profitable business alternatives. Demonstrate the ability to utilize business spreadsheet applications.

Grading:

Exams:

Examination format will be multiple choice. The randomized Midterm and Final exams will be taken on Moodle. Exam dates are indicated on the "Outline." Exams must be taken on the date scheduled unless prior arrangements have been made.

Homework:

There are 8 Homework assignment sets in CONNECT worth 100 points each. They are due by 2:00 pm on the dates listed on the outline. You may continue to work the assignment until the due date & time. Late assignments will not be accepted, and you will not be able to access the assignment in CONNECT after the due date. Each Homework assignment will be reviewed for reinforcement during Online class time. You are encouraged to read each Chapter and start your work prior to each online Chapter introduction. Students who assert initiative by working ahead and staying ahead on homework and quiz completion tend to outperform average students by a wide margin. Manage your time accordingly, like an Accounting professional.

Quizzes:

Following each online homework review session, a related chapter Quiz is assigned in CONNECT and is due by 11:00 pm on designated dates. There are 8 Quizzes worth 100 points each. There will be no make-ups or extensions for missed quiz deadlines. Manage your time accordingly, like an Accounting professional.

Outcomes:

Upon successful completion of this course, students will be able to:

- Gain understanding of the accounting cycle and evaluate business transactions using the accounting equation.
- Demonstrate the communication of accounting information by the use of commercially available spreadsheet software.
- Describe the four basic financial statements: Balance Sheet, Income Statement, Statement of Cash Flows, and Statement of Changes in Stockholders Equity.
- Describe the need for internal control procedures in an organization, and demonstrate an understanding of ethics in accounting.
- Use Cost-Profit-Volume analysis to calculate break-even points. Describe the purpose of budgeting in an organization.
- Calculate cost and efficiency variances using standard cost information.
