To make posting simple, I have to be the one who "publishes" your post - so it won't appear immediately. Since I'm way too lazy to exert any editorial control, if you work at LBCC and want to post, you'll be able to - I won't be rejecting or editing posts. If you want to bypass me and post on your own (though the "no anonymous posts" rule still applies), there's a way to do that if you're a little more tech-savvy - email me, and I'll set you up.
